500-person cap lifted as planned
for all hospitality venues, nightclubs and convention and function centres



Gathering limits removed
for private outdoor and home gatherings



On-arrival testing encouraged
and all travellers arriving at Perth Airport offered free RATs



National definition of a close contact adopted:
a household or intimate partner, or someone who has had more than four hours cumulative contact with a case in a residential/home setting without wearing a mask
